

ONTARIO ENERGY BOARD NOTICE TO CUSTOMERS OF ALECTRA UTILITIES CORPORATION

Alectra Utilities Corporation has applied to raise its electricity distribution rates effective January 1, 2023.

Alectra Utilities Corporation has applied to the Ontario Energy Board for Incremental Capital Module funding to undertake urgent underground cable renewal projects in the PowerStream Rate Zone and the Enersource Rate Zone for 2023 and 2024. If the application is approved as filed, a typical residential customer and a typical general service less than 50kW customer of Alectra Utilities Corporation in the PowerStream Rate Zone and the Enersource Rate Zone would see the following increase in 2023:

PowerStream Rate Zone

Residential 750 kWh	\$0.16 per month
General Service less than 50kW (2,000 kWh)	\$0.37 per month

Enersource Rate Zone

Residential 750 kWh	\$0.13 per month
General Service less than 50kW (2,000 kWh)	\$0.44 per month

Other customers, including businesses, may also be affected.

THE ONTARIO ENERGY BOARD WILL HOLD A PUBLIC HEARING

The Ontario Energy Board (OEB) will hold a public hearing to consider Alectra Utilities' application. During this hearing, we will question Alectra Utilities on its request for incremental capital funding. We will also hear questions and arguments from individuals that have registered to participate (called intervenors) in the OEB's hearing. At the end of this hearing, the OEB will decide what, if any, rate increase will be allowed.

The OEB is an independent and impartial public agency. We make decisions that serve the public interest. Our goal is to promote a financially viable and efficient energy sector that provides you with reliable energy services at a reasonable cost.

BE INFORMED AND HAVE YOUR SAY

You have the right to information regarding this application and to be involved in the process.

- You can review Alectra Utilities' application on the OEB's website now
- You can file a letter with your comments, which will be considered during the hearing
- You can become an intervenor. As an intervenor, you can ask questions about Alectra Utilities' application and make arguments on whether the OEB should approve Alectra Utilities' request. Apply by **June 20, 2022** or the hearing will go ahead without you and you will not receive any further notice of the proceeding
- At the end of the process, you can review the OEB's decision and its reasons on our website

ORAL VS. WRITTEN HEARINGS

There are two types of OEB hearings – oral and written. Alectra Utilities has applied for a written hearing. The OEB is considering this request. If you think an oral hearing is needed, you can write to the OEB to explain why by **June 20, 2022**.

PRIVACY

If you write a letter of comment, your name and the content of your letter will be placed on the public record and the OEB website. However, your personal telephone number, home address and email address will be removed. If you are a business, all your information will remain public. If you apply to become an intervenor, all information will be public.

This rate hearing will be held under section 78 of the Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998, S.O. 1998, c.15, Schedule B.



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
